As of this writing we have sold some 16,000 WBS ESV Study Edition Bibles, and our second shipment of 20,000 is due in Cedar Park in late May. Some churches are using the new Bibles as pew Bibles, some as school graduation gifts, and many are sending them to their WBS students. One congregation purchased 500 Bibles to distribute in area hospitals since "the Gideons are no longer placing Bibles in hospitals" in their area. Another is adding a Bible to each of the "Baskets for Babies" they provide to new mothers in their area. Our prayer is that this new Bible will help more Christians share the Gospel with those who need it. #### **NEVER GIVE UP**

(The following story came from Gale Scott, a long-time WBS study helper and my WBS co-worker in the Cedar Park TX WBS office. It is an excellent example of why we shouldn't get discouraged when we don't see what we judge to be good "results". We simply never know what God has in store.)

In the late 1980's I was studying with 2 brothers, Oludare Busari (age 14) and Oluwole Busari (age 13) in Nigeria. Both boys were excellent students and made the decision to be baptized. I made arrangements for a preacher to go to their remote village to conduct the baptisms. The boys' mother not only refused to let her sons be baptized but also forbade me any further contact with them. I prayed about these two boys for several years but eventually moved on to other students.

Eight years later Oludare wrote me a letter and said he had moved to Northern Nigeria to attend college. He said he had saved all of my letters and teaching material and was baptized as a result of the teaching he received when he was a young teenager. What is even more remarkable is that I received a letter that year from Oludare's mother who said she wanted to thank me for caring so much about her son.

We plant and water but it is God who gives the increase.

## JAIL/PRISON OUTREACH

- We have heard from several different jails and prisons recently about changes in what is allowed to be mailed into their facilities. For example, we learned last week that the Southwest Virginia Regional Jail Authority (Duffield, Tazewell, Haysi & Abingdon locations) will no longer accept mail with colored ink or colored paper. Obviously such changes are of great interest to WBS study helpers, and can cause you to adjust how you approach your ministry in some facilities. If you are considering beginning a prison/jail ministry outreach using WBS materials, I highly recommend you contact the facility you want to enter up front to be sure they will accept WBS materials and Bibles mailed to inmates there.
- If you are involved in jail/prison outreach, please consider attending the 44<sup>th</sup> annual National Jail and Prison Ministry Workshop, hosted this year by the Elysian Fields Avenue church of Christ in New Orleans. This event includes speakers with extensive experience in prison outreach, and offers great opportunities to learn how to make your outreach more effective. This year's event will be held June 14-16.
